Guest Soloist Justin Everette



An accomplished baritone and professional trombonist, Justin has recently moved to Perth from the USA. Having worked 10 years on board Royal Caribbean Cruise lines as a Headline Entertainer, Musical Director, Singer and Trombonist, Justin loves entertaining.

Before cruising Justin was a regular guest trombonist with the Chattanooga Symphony Orchestra. He attended Lee University in Tennessee on vocal scholarship to sing in the Voices of Lee. Justin made regular appearances in churches, concert halls, rallies, and sung for President G. W. Bush in the White House. He has recorded on multiple studio albums, and toured much of the United States and internationally, all while completing a bachelor's degree in music education.

His passion for teaching and sharing his gift continues as a Music Teacher at Scotch College in Perth.

Justin is actively performing and touring here in Australia as frontman for the Oz Big Band. He is also a valued member of the WA Brass Band and regularly plays with WASO and is a former Bass trombonist in WA Wind Symphony. You can also find him headlining his own show "Blue Eyes to Bublé" a tribute to the crooners.

Guest Soloist Bronwyn Sprogowski



Bronwyn Sprogowski spent her formative years singing with the Kalamunda Youth Swing Band (KYSB) and West Australian Youth Jazz Orchestra (WAYJO).

As a member of these youth bands, Bronwynn was fortunate to be part of the support act for artists including George Benson, Shirley Bassey and Roberta Flack. Bronwyn travelled to the USA where she had the opportunity of performing alongside jazz greats Ellis Marsalis & Lionel Hampton. She also performed alongside American tenor giant, Frank Foster, the late Don Burrows as well as James Morrison.

After graduating from the WAAPA in the 90's, Bronwynn formed her own quintet performing at the Perth Jazz Society, Jazz Fremantle, York Jazz Festival, The Ellington Jazz Club and the Cairns Jazz Festival. She has also toured WA as part of the Billie Holiday Story.

A former vocal educator in the WAAPA Jazz Department, she currently teaches voice and directs choirs in various Perth secondary schools and is often found singing at the local jazz clubs with a plethora of different groups.
